**Situation report regarding Flood/ Heavy rainfall as on 06<sup>th</sup> June, 2022 at 1800 Hrs.**

**1. Forecast:-**

➤ **India Meteorological Department (IMD):**

	<b>Heavy rainfall</b>	At isolated places over Sub-Himalayan West Bengal & Sikkim, Nagaland, Manipur, Mizoram & Tripura, South Interior Karnataka and Kerala & Mahe.
	<b>Thunderstorm accompanied with lightning/gusty winds</b>	At isolated places very likely over Andaman & Nicobar Islands; with lightning/gusty winds (speed 30-40 kmph) over Jharkhand, Gangetic West Bengal, Coastal Andhra Pradesh & Yanam and Rayalaseema and with lightning at isolated places over Chhattisgarh, Bihar, Sub-Himalayan West Bengal & Sikkim, Odisha, Arunachal Pradesh, Assam & Meghalaya, Nagaland, Manipur, Mizoram & Tripura, Madhya Maharashtra, Marathwada. Karnataka, Tamilnadu, Puducherry & Karaikal, Kerala & Mahe and Lakshadweep.

➤ **Significant Weather Features:-**

- Under the influence of north-south trough runs roughly and strong southwesterly winds from Bay of Bengal to northeast India in lower tropospheric levels:

i) Widespread light/moderate rainfall with isolated heavy to very heavy rainfall very likely over Arunachal Pradesh, Assam & Meghalaya, Nagaland, Manipur, Mizoram & Tripura and Sub-Himalayan West Bengal & Sikkim during next 5 days. Isolated extremely heavy rainfall also likely over Meghalaya during 08th-10th June.

ii) Isolated/scattered rainfall with thunderstorm/lightning/gusty winds very likely over Bihar, Jharkhand, Odisha and Gangetic West Bengal during next 5 days with isolated heavy rainfall over Bihar on 06th June, 2022.

**3. Loss & Damage reported in Assam:-**

- At present 04 districts viz. Cachar, Kamrup (M), Morigaon and Udalguri district are affected from flood.
- So far **26,599** numbers of people have been safely evacuated by forces/ agencies.
- **38** persons have lost their life due to flood/landslide in this season (i.e. from 6th April, 2022).

**Deployment of NDRF:-**

- **Total 91** teams of NDRF are deployed in different parts of country to assist local administration for relief and rescue operation.

**Today NIL reports received from 06 States/ UTs:** - Goa, Himachal Pradesh, Meghalaya, Nagaland, Tripura, and Uttarakhand.

**Today situation report not received from 27 States/ UTs:-** Andhra Pradesh, Arunachal Pradesh, Bihar, Chhattisgarh, Gujarat, Haryana, Jharkhand, Madhya Pradesh, Maharashtra, Manipur, Mizoram, Odisha, Punjab, Rajasthan, Sikkim, Tamil Nadu, Telangana, Uttar Pradesh, West Bengal, Andaman & Nicobar, Chandigarh, Dadra Nagar Haveli & Daman Diu, Delhi, Lakshadweep, J&K, Ladakh and Puducherry.
