- A low pressure area lies over south Jharkhand & neighbourhood. It is very likely to move west-northwestwards and weaken during next 24 hours.
- Due to the likely formation of a Low Pressure Area, fairly widespread to widespread rainfall with isolated heavy to very heavy falls is likely over Odisha and Gangetic West Bengal during 18th & 19th August.

4. Other Incident-

- Landslide in Kerala: Landslide occurred in Tata tea Company Pettimudi Munnar Kerala. 58 (02 Dead body recovered today) persons have been reported dead, 12 persons got injured and 12 persons are still missing. Search and Rescue operation continue by NDRF, Fire, Forest, Police, Emergency Response Team and Local Administration.
- Landslide at Karnataka Update: Landslides incidents occurred on 06.08.2020 in Karnataka-Bhramagiri hills, Bhagamandala, Madikeri Taluk. 01 dead body has been retrieved from the debris. Search and rescue operation continues in Bramgiri Hills, Tala Cauvery, to trace out remaining 03 missing persons.
