- Impact: The intense spell over Bihar and Northeast India may accentuate existing flood conditions and lead to landslides in some areas of Northeastern states and Sub-Himalayan West Bengal & Sikkim.
- Intense thunderstorm & lightning potential zone: Moderate to severe thunderstorm & lightning at isolated places very likely over Haryana, Chandigarh & Delhi, northwest Uttar Pradesh, East Uttar Pradesh, Bihar, East Madhya Pradesh, Vidarbha, Jharkhand, West Bengal, Meghalaya and north Odisha during next 12 hours.
