Significant Weather Features:

- A Low Pressure Area lies over Northwest & adjoining Westcentral Bay of Bengal off Odisha-north Andhra Pradesh coasts. Under its influence, fairly widespread to widespread rainfall and moderate thunderstorm & lightning very likely over Odisha, Jharkhand, Gangetic West Bengal during next 3-4 days. Isolated heavy rainfall very likely over Odisha during 02nd - 06th and over Gangetic West Bengal & Jharkhand during 02nd-04th October, 2020.
- Fairly widespread rainfall with isolated heavy falls very likely over Assam & Meghalaya and Tripura during 02nd-06th October, 2020.
