**Significant Weather Features:**

- Isolated heavy rainfall very likely over Odisha during 03rd-06th October and over Gangetic West Bengal & Jharkhand on 03rd October and over Chhattisgarh & adjoining East Madhya Pradesh during 06th-07th October, 2020. Isolated heavy to very rainfall also very likely over Odisha on 03rd October, 2020.
- Fairly widespread to widespread rainfall with isolated heavy falls very likely over Arunachal Pradesh, Assam & Meghalaya and Nagaland, Manipur, Mizoram & Tripura during 03rd-05th October, 2020.
