**Significant Weather Features:**

➤ A low pressure area is very likely to form over north Andaman Sea & adjoining Eastcentral Bay of Bengal on 09 October 2020. It is very likely to concentrate into a Depression over central Bay of Bengal during subsequent 24 hours. It is very likely to move west-northwestwards and cross north Andhra Pradesh & adjoining south Odisha coast as a depression around 11 October afternoon/evening.
