➤ The Depression over Westcentral Bay of Bengal moved west-northwestwards with a speed of 06 kmph during past 06 hours, intensified into a Deep Depression and lay centred at 1130 hrs

IST of today, the 12th October, 2020 near latitude 15.9°N and longitude 84.8°E, about 250 km south-southeast of Vishakhapatnam (Andhra Pradesh), 290 km east-southeast of Kakinada (Andhra Pradesh) and 330 km east-southeast of Narsapur (Andhra Pradesh). It is very likely to move west-northwestwards and cross north Andhra Pradesh coast between Narsapur & Vishakhapatnam, close to Kakinada during the early morning of 13th October, 2020 as a Deep Depression with wind speed of 55-65 kmph gusting to 75 kmph.
