Significant Weather Features:-

- A cyclonic circulation lies over southeast & adjoining southwest Arabian Sea in the lower levels and a trough runs from this cyclonic circulation to Comorin area at lower levels. Under its influence, fairly widespread to widespread rainfall accompanied with thunderstorm & lightning and isolated heavy rainfall very likely over Kerala and Lakshadweep on 18th & 19th November, 2020 and decrease significantly thereafter.
- Under the influence of above systems, a Low Pressure Area is likely to form over central parts of South Arabian Sea around 19th November, 2020. It is very likely to move west-northwestwards and concentrate into a Depression over central parts of South Arabian sea and adjoining central Arabian sea during subsequent 48 hours.
- Under the influence of a fresh easterly wave, fairly widespread to widespread rainfall accompanied with thunderstorm & lightning and isolated heavy rainfall very likely over Andaman & Nicobar Islands.
