Significant Weather Features :-

- The Depression over Northwest Bay of Bengal off West Bengal - Bangladesh coasts moved north-northeastwards with a speed of 25 kmph during past 06 hours, crossed West Bengal & adjoining Bangladesh coasts near latitude 21.8°N and longitude 88.5°E between 1130 & 1230 hrs IST of today, the 23rd October 2020 with maximum sustained wind speed of 44-55 kmph gusting to 65 kmph as a Depression. It moved across across 24 Parganas Districts of West Bengal and lay centred at 1430 hrs IST of today, the 23rd October, 2020 over Bangladesh near Latitude 22.5°N & Longitude 89.1°E about 140 km northeast of Sagar Islands (West Bengal) and 130 km west-northwest of Khepupara (Bangladesh) and about 190 km southwest of Dhaka (Bangladesh). It is very likely to move further north-northeastwards maintaining the intensity of Depression for next 12 hours and weaken thereafter into a well marked low pressure area over Bangladesh. Under the influence of above system.
- Light to moderate rainfall at most places with heavy to very heavy falls at a few places and extremely heavy falls at isolated places very likely over Tripura; heavy to very heavy falls at a few places over Nagaland, Manipur, Mizoram and south Assam & Meghalaya. Light to moderate rainfall at many places with heavy falls at isolated places likely over remaining districts of Assam on 23rd October, 2020.

- Conditions continue to be favourable for further withdrawal of Southwest Monsoon from remaining parts of Jharkhand, Chhattisgarh, Madhya Pradesh, Gujarat and North & Central Arabian Sea; some parts of Odisha and north Maharashtra during next 2-days and from remaining parts of West Bengal, Sikkim, Odisha, Telengana, parts of north-eastern states, Andhra Pradesh and most parts of Maharashtra during subsequent 2 days.
- SEOCs of Tamilnadu, West Bengal, Assam, Manipur have telephonically confirmed that no damage has been reported so far on account of Depression. However, damaged report in this regard, if any, will be sent tomorrow.
