Significant Weather Features:-

- A cyclonic circulation lies over Tamil Nadu coast & adjoining Southwest Bay of Bengal in lower tropospheric level and another cyclonic circulation lies over Southeast Arabian Sea off Kerala coast in lower & mid tropospheric level. Under the influence of these system;
 - i) Isolated to scattered rainfall activity with moderate thunderstorm & lightening very likely over Tamilnadu, Puducherry & Karaikal and Kerala & Mahe. Isolated heavy rainfall also very likely over Tamilnadu during next 5 days and over Kerala on 03 November, 2020.
- A Low Pressure Area lies over Eastcentral Bay of Bengal off Myanmar coast and associated cyclonic circulation extends upto mid tropospheric levels. This system is likely to move towards Bangladesh coast during next 48 hours. A trough runs from the cyclonic circulation associated with the this low pressure area to Bangladesh across northeast Bay of Bengal in lower tropospheric levels. Under its influence:
 - i) Scattered to widespread rainfall activity very likely over Andaman & Nicobar islands and Nagaland, Manipur, Mizoram & Tripura and isolated to scattered rainfall activity over Assam & Meghalaya, Arunachal Pradesh and West Bengal & Sikkim during next 3-4 days.
 - ii) Isolated heavy rainfall with moderate thunderstorm & lightning very likely over Assam & Meghalaya and Nagaland, Manipur, Mizoram & Tripura during next 2 days. Isolated very heavy rainfall also likely over Nagaland, Manipur, Mizoram & Tripura on today, the 31 October, 2020.
 - iii) Squally weather (wind speed 40-50 kmph) very likely over Eastcentral & adjoining Northeast Bay of Bengal on 31 October and over Northeast & adjoining Eastcentral Bay of Bengal on 01 November, 2020. Fisherman are advised not to venture into this area.
- Generally dry weather very likely over most parts of Northwest, West, Central and East India during next 5 days
