Subject: Depression over southeast Jharkhand and adjoining north Odisha & Gangetic West Bengal

The Depression over Gangetic West Bengal & adjoining Jharkhand and north Odisha moved westnorthwestwards with a speed of 13 kmph during past 06 hours and lay centred at 0830 hrs IST of today, the 22 nd July 2018 over southeast Jharkhand and adjoining north Odisha & Gangetic West Bengal near latitude 22.6 0N and longitude 86.2 0E, about 20 km south of Jamshedpur. It is very likely to continue to move west-northwestwards & maintain its intensity during next 24 hours and weaken into a well marked low pressure area thereafter.
