**Subject**: Depression over south Jharkhand & neighbourhood

The Depression over south Jharkhand & neighbourhood moved further northwestwards with a speed of 12 kmph during past 06 hours and lay centred at 2330 hrs IST of today, the 22 nd July 2018 over west Jharkhand and neighbourhood near latitude 23.5 0N and longitude 84.50E, about 83 km west-northwest of Ranchi and 70 km southeast of Daltonganj. It is very likely to move northwestwards & maintain its intensity during next 12 hours and weaken into a well marked low pressure area thereafter.

- Squally winds speed reaching 40-50 kmph gusting to 60 kmph very likely along & off north Odisha & adjoining West Bengal coasts and over north Bay of Bengal during next 12 hours.

**Sea Condition:**

- Sea condition will be rough to very rough along & off north Odisha and adjoining West Bengal coasts & over north Bay of Bengal during next 12 hours.

**Fishermen Warning:**

Fishermen are advised not to venture into north Bay of Bengal along & off north Odisha & adjoining West Bengal coasts during next 12 hours.
