**Subject: SEVERE FLOOD SITUATION (ORANGE BULLETIN)**  
**(Where water level is within Danger and Highest Flood Levels)**

**Assam**

1- River Brahmaputra at Neamatighat in Jorhat district of Assam continues to flow in SEVERE SITUATION at 09:00 hrs today. At 09:00 hrs, it was flowing at a level of 85.48 m with Falling trend which is 0.44 m above its Danger Level of 85.04 m and 1.89 m below its previous HFL of 87.37 m (1991-07-11).

2- River Jiabharali at NT Road Crossing Jia-Bharali in Sonitpur district of Assam continues to flow in SEVERE SITUATION at 09:00 hrs today. At 09:00 hrs, it was flowing at a level of 77.28 m with Steady trend which is 0.28 m above its Danger Level of 77.0 m and 1.22 m below its previous HFL of 78.5 m (2007-07-26).

5- River Dikhow at Sivasagar in Sibsagar district of Assam continues to flow in SEVERE SITUATION at 09:00 hrs today. At 09:00 hrs, it was flowing at a level of 92.97 m with Falling trend which is 0.57 m above its Danger Level of 92.4 m and 1.22 m below its previous HFL of 94.19 m (1998-06-25).

6- River Dhansiri (South) at Numaligarh in Golaghat district of Assam continues to flow in SEVERE SITUATION at 09:00 hrs today. At 09:00 hrs, it was flowing at a level of 78.58 m with Rising trend which is 1.16 m above its Danger Level of 77.42 m and 1.29 m below its previous HFL of 79.87 m (1985-09-24).

**Bihar**

3- River Bagmati at Benibad in Muzaffarpur district of Bihar continues to flow in SEVERE SITUATION at 10:00 hrs today. At 10:00 hrs, it was flowing at a level of 48.74 m with Steady trend which is 0.06 m above its Danger Level of 48.68 m and 1.27 m below its previous HFL of 50.01 m (2004-07-12).

4- River Kosi at Basua in Supaul \* district of Bihar continues to flow in SEVERE SITUATION at 10:00 hrs today. At 10:00 hrs, it was flowing at a level of 47.88 m with Rising trend which is 0.13 m above its Danger Level of 47.75 m and 1.36 m below its previous HFL of 49.24 m (2017-08-13).
