Subject: SEVERE FLOOD SITUATION (ORANGE BULLETIN)
(Where water level is within Danger and Highest Flood Levels)

Assam

1- River Brahmaputra at Neamatighat in Jorhat district of Assam continues to flow in SEVERE SITUATION at 21:00 hrs today. At 21:00 hrs, it was flowing at a level of 85.45 m with Falling trend which is 0.41 m above its Danger Level of 85.04 m and 1.92 m below its previous HFL of 87.37 m (1991-07-11).

2- River Jiabharali at NT Road Crossing Jia-Bharali in Sonitpur district of Assam continues to flow in SEVERE SITUATION at 21:00 hrs today. At 21:00 hrs, it was flowing at a level of 77.2 m with Rising trend which is 0.20 m above its Danger Level of 77.0 m and 1.30 m below its previous HFL of 78.5 m (2007-07-26).

4- River Dikhow at Sivasagar in Sibsagar district of Assam continues to flow in SEVERE SITUATION at 21:00 hrs today. At 21:00 hrs, it was flowing at a level of 92.44 m with Falling trend which is 0.04 m above its Danger Level of 92.4 m and 1.75 m below its previous HFL of 94.19 m (1998-06-25).

5- River Dhansiri (South) at Numaligarh in Golaghat district of Assam continues to flow in SEVERE SITUATION at 21:00 hrs today. At 21:00 hrs, it was flowing at a level of 78.44 m with Falling trend which is 1.02 m above its Danger Level of 77.42 m and 1.43 m below its previous HFL of 79.87 m (1985-09-24).

<u>Bihar</u>

3- River Kosi at Basua in Supaul * district of Bihar continues to flow in SEVERE SITUATION at 21:00 hrs today. At 21:00 hrs, it was flowing at a level of 48.03 m with Rising trend which is 0.28 m above its Danger Level of 47.75 m and 1.21 m below its previous HFL of 49.24 m (2017-08-13).
