Subject: SEVERE FLOOD SITUATION (ORANGE BULLETIN)
(Where water level is within Danger and Highest Flood Levels)

Assam

1- River Brahmaputra at Neamatighat in Jorhat district of Assam continues to flow in SEVERE SITUATION at 15:00 hrs today. At 15:00 hrs, it was flowing at a level of 85.41 m with Falling trend which is 0.37 m above its Danger Level of 85.04 m and 1.96 m below its previous HFL of 87.37 m (1991-07-11).

2- River Jiabharali at NT Road Crossing Jia-Bharali in Sonitpur district of Assam continues to flow in SEVERE SITUATION at 15:00 hrs today. At 15:00 hrs, it was flowing at a level of 77.34 m with Rising trend which is 0.34 m above its Danger Level of 77.0 m and 1.16 m below its previous HFL of 78.5 m (2007-07-26).

4- River Dhansiri (South) at Numaligarh in Golaghat district of Assam continues to flow in SEVERE SITUATION at 15:00 hrs today. At 15:00 hrs, it was flowing at a level of 78.16 m with Falling trend which is 0.74 m above its Danger Level of 77.42 m and 1.71 m below its previous HFL of 79.87 m (1985-09-24).

<u>Bihar</u>

3- River Kosi at Basua in Supaul * district of Bihar continues to flow in SEVERE SITUATION at 15:00 hrs today. At 15:00 hrs, it was flowing at a level of 48.18 m with Steady trend which is 0.43 m above its Danger Level of 47.75 m and 1.06 m below its previous HFL of 49.24 m (2017-08-13).

5- River Kosi at Baltara in Khangaria district of Bihar continues to flow in SEVERE SITUATION at 15:00 hrs today. At 15:00 hrs, it was flowing at a level of 34.08 m with Rising trend which is 0.23 m above its Danger Level of 33.85 m and 2.32 m below its previous HFL of 36.4 m (1987-08-15).
