**Subject: SEVERE FLOOD SITUATION (ORANGE BULLETIN)**  
**(Where water level is within Danger and Highest Flood Levels)**

**Assam**

1- River Brahmaputra at Neamatighat in Jorhat district of Assam continues to flow in SEVERE SITUATION at 09:00 hrs today. At 09:00 hrs, it was flowing at a level of 85.46 m with Steady trend which is 0.42 m above its Danger Level of 85.04 m and 1.91 m below its previous HFL of 87.37 m (1991-07-11).

3- River Dhansiri (South) at Numaligarh in Golaghat district of Assam continues to flow in SEVERE SITUATION at 09:00 hrs today. At 09:00 hrs, it was flowing at a level of 77.99 m with Falling trend which is 0.57 m above its Danger Level of 77.42 m and 1.88 m below its previous HFL of 79.87 m (1985-09-24).

**Bihar**

2- River Kosi at Basua in Supaul \* district of Bihar continues to flow in SEVERE SITUATION at 09:00 hrs today. At 09:00 hrs, it was flowing at a level of 48.25 m with Rising trend which is 0.50 m above its Danger Level of 47.75 m and 0.99 m below its previous HFL of 49.24 m (2017-08-13).

4- River Kosi at Baltara in Khangaria district of Bihar continues to flow in SEVERE SITUATION at 09:00 hrs today. At 09:00 hrs, it was flowing at a level of 34.17 m with Rising trend which is 0.32 m above its Danger Level of 33.85 m and 2.23 m below its previous HFL of 36.4 m (1987-08-15).
