**Weather Warning during next 5 days**

19 April (Day 1): ♦ Thundersquall (wind speed reaching 60-70 kmph) accompanied with hail and lightning at isolated places very likely over Odisha.

♦ Thundersquall (wind speed reaching 50-60 kmph) accompanied with lightning at isolated places very likely over Gangetic West Bengal.

♦ Thunderstorm accompanied with gusty winds (wind speed reaching 30-40 kmph) and lightning at isolated places very likely over Tamilnadu, Coastal Andhra Pradesh, Jharkhand, Assam & Meghalaya and Nagaland, Manipur, Mizoram & Tripura.

♦ Thunderstorm accompanied with gusty winds (wind speed reaching 40-50 kmph) and lightning at isolated places very likely over Kerala and Telangana.

20 April (Day 2): ♦ Thundersquall (wind speed reaching 50-60 kmph) accompanied with lightning at isolated places very likely over Assam & Meghalaya and Nagaland, Manipur, Mizoram & Tripura.

♦ Thunderstorm accompanied with gusty winds (wind speed reaching 30-40 kmph) and lightning at isolated places very likely over Tamilnadu, Coastal Andhra Pradesh, Rayalseema, Gangetic West Bengal and Odisha.

♦ Thunderstorm accompanied with gusty winds (wind speed reaching 40-50 kmph) and lightning at isolated places very likely over Kerala, South Interior Karnataka and Telangana.

21 April (Day 3): ♦ Thundersquall (wind speed reaching 50-60 kmph) accompanied with lightning at isolated places very likely over Assam & Meghalaya and Nagaland, Manipur, Mizoram & Tripura. ♦ Thunderstorm accompanied with gusty winds (wind speed reaching 30-40 kmph) and lightning at isolated places likely over Coastal Andhra Pradesh.

♦ Thunderstorm accompanied with gusty winds (wind speed reaching 40-50 kmph) and lightning at isolated places likely over Telangana, Uttarakhand, Sub-Himalayan West Bengal & Sikkim and Odisha.

♦ Heat Wave conditions at isolated pockets likely over Rajasthan.

22 April (Day 4): ♦ Thunderstorm accompanied with gusty winds (wind speed reaching 30-40 kmph) and lightning at isolated places likely over Gangetic West Bengal.

♦ Thunderstorm accompanied with gusty winds (wind speed reaching 40-50 kmph) and lightning at isolated places likely over Sub-Himalayan West Bengal & Sikkim, Jharkhand, Odisha, Assam & Meghalaya and Nagaland, Manipur, Mizoram & Tripura.

♦ Heat Wave conditions likely over some parts of Rajasthan.

23 April (Day 5): ♦ Thunderstorm accompanied with gusty winds (wind speed reaching 30-40 kmph) and lightning at isolated places likely over Gangetic West Bengal.

♦ Thunderstorm accompanied with gusty winds (wind speed reaching 40-50 kmph) and lightning at isolated places likely over Sub-Himalayan West Bengal & Sikkim, Jharkhand, Odisha, Assam & Meghalaya and Nagaland, Manipur, Mizoram & Tripura.

♦ Heat Wave conditions likely over some parts of Rajasthan
