Subject: Deep Depression over Gulf of Aden

The depression over Gulf of Aden moved westwards during past 6 hrs with a speed of 11 kmph, intensified into a deep depression and lay centered at 0530 hrs IST of today, the 17 th May 2018 over Gulf of Aden near latitude 13.2 0N and longitude 49.0 0E; about 430 km east-northeast of Aden (Yemen) and 530 km west-northwest of Socotra Islands. It is very likely to intensify further into a cyclonic storm during next 12 hrs. It is very likely to move initially westwards during next 12 hrs and

then west-southwestwards during subsequent 24 hrs.

Warning

(a) Wind

Squally winds speed reaching 50-60 kmph gusting to 70 kmph is very likely around the system centre covering Gulf of Aden and adjoining areas of westcentral and southwest Arabian Sea during the next 12 hrs. It would then increase gradually becoming 65-75 kmph gusting to 85 kmph during subsequent 12 hours and decrease thereafter.

(b) Sea condition

Sea condition will be very rough around the system centre covering Gulf of Aden and adjoining areas of westcentral and southwest Arabian Sea during the next 48 hrs.

(c) Fishermen warning

Fishermen are advised not to venture into Gulf of Aden and adjoining areas of westcentral and southwest Arabian Sea during the next 48 hrs..

In view of above, State Governments are advised to keep a close watch, monitor the situation in their areas regularly and take appropriate precautionary measures. District authorities are to be advised accordingly.
