I am directed to say that as a part of the endeavour of this Department to strengthen natural disaster management capacity at National/State level, 4 digit dial numbers have been allotted for natural disasters as public utility service by the Bharat Sanchar Nigam Limited as per the details below:

- i) "1070" for the Control Rooms of Central Relief Commissioner and Relief Commissioners of all States/Uts.
- ii) "1077" for the Control Rooms of District Magistrates of all districts in the States throughout the country and the Relief Commissioner, NCT of Delhi.

The incoming calls on these numbers will not be metered and will be free. These numbers can be given 2 lines and will have the facility of pre-recorded voice player and messages recording. Bharat Sanchar Nigam Ltd. Have issued necessary instructions to all their field units vide their letter No.3-1/2000-PH.1 dated 12.02.2002, copy enclosed for ready reference.

It may be seen that 4 digit dial number facility by Bharat Sanchar Nigam Ltd will greatly help in net-working and communication by all those engaged in the management of disasters particularly those working in the fields including the voluntary organisations and NGOs.

It is requested that further necessary action may kindly be taken for installation of these numbers as indicated above under intimation to this Department and wide publicity be also given for the information of the general public, voluntary organisations, NGOs and all those who are involved in the disaster management.
