Very Severe Cyclonic Storm (VSCS) 'Mekunu' over Westcentral Arabian Sea

The Very Severe Cyclonic Storm 'Mekunu' over Westcentral & adjoining Southwest Arabian Sea moved further north-northwestwards with a speed of 09 Kmph during past 06 hours and lay centered at 0530 hrs IST of 25th May 2018 over Westcentral Arabian Sea near latitude 15.2° N and longitude 54.5° E, about 290 km north-northeast of Socotra Islands and 210 km south-southeast of Salalah (Oman). It is very likely to move north-northwestwards and cross south Oman-southeast Yemen coasts between 53°E and 54°E close to South of Salalah, around midnight of
