Sub: **Extremely Severe Cyclonic Storm (ESCS) 'Mekunu' over Westcentral Arabian Sea**

The **Extremely Severe Cyclonic Storm 'Mekunu'** over Westcentral Arabian Sea moved further north-northwestwards with a speed of 11 Kmph during past 06 hours and lay centered at 1130 hrs IST of today, 25th May 2018 over Westcentral Arabian Sea near latitude 15.8^oN and longitude 54.4^oE, about 350 km north-northeast of Socotra Islands and 140 km south-southeast of Salalah(Oman). It is very likely to move north-northwestwards and cross south Oman-southeast Yemen coasts between 53^oE and 54^oE close to south of Salalah, around midnight of today, the 25th May, 2018/early morning of tomorrow, the 26th May, 2018 as an Extremely Severe Cyclonic Storm with wind speed 160-170 gusting to 190 kmph.

Warning:

As the system is away from Indian coast, no adverse weather is expected along & off west coast of India and Lakshadweep.

Wind Warning:

- Gale winds speed reaching 160-170 Kmph gusting to 180 Kmph is very likely to prevail over Westcentral Arabian Sea during next 12 hours and wind gradually decrease becoming 80-90 Kmph gusting to 100 Kmph in subsequent 06 hours over Westcentral Arabian Sea.


Sea Condition:

- Sea condition is phenomenal over Westcentral Arabian Sea and will continue to be phenomenal till 26th morning. It will improve gradually thereafter.

Fishermen Warning:

- Fishermen are advised not to venture into Westcentral Arabian Sea till 26th May.

2. State Governments are advised to keep a close watch, monitor the situation in their areas regularly and take appropriate precautionary measures. District authorities are to be advised accordingly.
