Sub: Very Severe Cyclonic Storm (VSCS) 'Mekunu' over Westcentral & adjoining Southwest Arabian Sea

The Very Severe Cyclonic Storm 'Mekunu' over Westcentral & adjoining Southwest Arabian Sea moved further north-northwestwards with a speed of 11 Kmph during past 06 hours and lay centered at 1730 hrs IST of 24th May 2018 over Westcentral & adjoining Southwest Arabian Sea near latitude 14.30N and longitude 55.20E, about 230 km north-northeast of Socotra Islands and 320 km south-southeast of Salalah (Oman). It is very likely to move nearly northwards during next 24 hours and then north-northwestwards and cross south Oman - southeast Yemen coasts

between 53°E and 55°E close to Salalah, by 26th May, 2018 early morning.

As the system is expected to move away from Indian coast, no adverse weather is expected along & off west coast of India and Lakshadweep.

Wind Warning:

Gale winds speed reaching 145-155 Kmph gusting to 175 Kmph is prevailing over Westcentral Arabian Sea & adjoining southwest Arabian Sea.

Sea Condition:

Sea condition is phenomenal over West Central and adjoining southwest Arabian Sea and will continue to be phenomenal over westcentral Arabian Sea till 26th morning. It will improve gradually thereafter. The sea condition over adjacent areas of southwest Arabian Sea will remain phenomenal till 24th evening and improve gradually thereafter.

Fishermen Warning:

- Fishermen are advised not to venture into southwest Arabian Sea till 24th May and into west-central Arabian Sea till 26th May.
- State Governments are advised to keep a close watch, monitor the situation in their areas regularly and take appropriate precautionary measures. District authorities are to be advised accordingly.
