**Sub: Very Severe Cyclonic Storm (VSCS) 'Mekunu' over Westcentral & adjoining Southwest Arabian Sea**  
The Very Severe Cyclonic Storm 'Mekunu' over Westcentral & adjoining Southwest Arabian Sea moved further north-northwestwards with a speed of 13 Kmph during past 06 hours and lay centered at 2030 hrs IST of 24<sup>th</sup> May 2018 over Westcentral & adjoining Southwest Arabian Sea near latitude 14.6<sup>o</sup>N and longitude 55.1<sup>o</sup>E, about 250 km north-northeast of Socotra Islands and 290 km south-southeast of Salalah (Oman). It is very likely to move nearly northwards during next 24 hours and then north-northwestwards and cross south Oman - southeast Yemen coasts between 53<sup>o</sup>E and 55<sup>o</sup>E close to Salalah, by 26<sup>th</sup> May, 2018 early morning.

As the system is away from Indian coast, no adverse weather is expected along & off west coast of India and Lakshadweep.

**Wind Warning:**

- Gale winds speed reaching 145-155 Kmph gusting to 175 Kmph is very likely to prevail over Westcentral Arabian Sea & adjoining southwest Arabian Sea during next 24 hours and 120-130 kmph gusting to 145 kmph in subsequent 24 hours over Westcentral Arabian Sea.


**Sea Condition:**

- Sea condition is phenomenal over Westcentral and adjoining southwest Arabian Sea and will continue to be phenomenal over Westcentral Arabian Sea till 26<sup>th</sup> morning. It will improve gradually thereafter. The sea condition over adjacent areas of southwest Arabian Sea will remain phenomenal till 25<sup>th</sup> morning and improve gradually thereafter.

**Fishermen Warning:**

- Fishermen are advised not to venture into Southwest Arabian Sea till 25<sup>th</sup> May and into Westcentral Arabian Sea till 26<sup>th</sup> May.

2. State Governments are advised to keep a close watch, monitor the situation in their areas regularly and take appropriate precautionary measures. District authorities are to be advised accordingly.
