Sub: Extremely Severe Cyclonic Storm (ESCS) 'Mekunu' crossed coast

The Extremely Severe Cyclonic Storm 'Mekunu' over westcentral Arabian Sea moved northwestwards with a speed of 07 Kmph during past 06 hours and lay centered at 2330 hours IST of 25th May, 2018 over westcentral Arabain Sea off south Oman and adjoining southeast Yemen coast near latitude 16.7°N and longitude 53.9E, about 40 km west southwest of Salalah. It crossed south Oman coast near latitude 16.85°N and longitude 53.75°E, about 40 kmph west-southwest of Salalah during 0000 to 0100 hours IST of 26th May, 2018. It lay centered at 0100 hours IST of 26th May over south Oman near latitude 17.0°N and longitude 53.6°E, about 50 km west of Salalah.
