Brief Report on Coal Mine Incident of 3 Kilo Umrangso, District- Dima Hasao, Assam
as on 06.02.2025

1. Back ground: -

On 06.01.2025 at about 1700 hrs, an incident of Coal Mine collapse took place at 3 kilo Umrangso Talluka area, u/PS- Umrangso in District Dima Hasao, Assam, Location of the incident site (**Lat: 25^o.28'35.0" N Long: 92^o.35'40.9" E**). As per initial information 11 Miners were reported to be trapped due to sudden seepage of water in the Quarry. DC & SP, Fire & Emergency Services Officials of District - Dima Hasao and SDRF reached the incident site immediately after incident. The SDRF Teams started the Search & Rescue operation, The underground coal mine is having 90 mtr tapering shaft with diameter 3 mtr at top and 1 mtr at base average 1.5 mtr. There are four galleries of 90 mtr each with height of 1 mtr and varying with 1 to 1.5 Meter, all are filled with water.

2. Search & Rescue Operation Team of various Organizations who were deployed so far:

- NDRF (30 Personnel).
- SDRF and Fire & ES (22 Personnel).
- Divers of 21 Paras SF, Engineer Task Force, Medical Team, Support staff from Army (39 Personnel).
- Deep Divers Team of Assam Rifles (44 Personnel).
- Deep Divers Team of Navy (12 Personnel).
- Team of ASDMA, DDMA Dima Hasao and DDRF Dima Hasao (12 Personnel).
- CIL Generator Operator Team (6 Personnel).
- Team of APRO (7 Personnel).
- Team of Assam Police (20 Personnel).
- Team of PHED (team strength: 09 Personnel).
- Experts of GSI, Central Ground Water Board and NE Office (01 each).
- Medical Team of Haflong Civil Hospital, Dima Hasao, Assam (05 Personnel).

So far, 04 dead bodies out of 11 stranded miners were recovered from the quarry (01 body was recovered on 8th January 2025 and 03 bodies were recovered on 11th January 2025 by 21 Paras), remaining are still suspected to be trapped inside the Coal Mine.

3. Current Status: -

- Total 17 nos. dewatering pumps are installed at the incident site, out of which 12 nos are operating and 05 nos. are under maintenance.
- Current water level is approximately 4.5 Meters.
- Today 04 Underwater Divers of 21 PARA(SF) along with diving equipments moved towards 3 Kilo coal mine by road.
- Medical Team of Haflong Civil Hospital, Dima Hasao, Assam is deployed for medical support and treatment.



- Search & Rescue Operation is underway by Indian Army, NDRF, SDRF, DDRF, Police, PHED, Coal India Ltd. and local administration.

4. Steps taken by the Central Government: -

- Situation is continuously being monitored by Central Government at the highest level.
- All necessary coordination among Central and State agencies are being carried out as per requirement.
- ICR-ER (Both Control Rooms of MHA) monitoring the situation 24X7 and all possible help is being provided to the State.

5. Efforts made by Central and State Agency: -

- A total of 19 nos. De-watering pumps have been used so far for de-watering work.
- A Drone operation conducted by the Drone Team of ASDMA over 260 acres area for possible inundated mines that might be connected to the incident mine.
- The mapping drone equipped with RTK mapping were operated to map out an area around the incident site to create a high-resolution map of all the mines that are filled with water.
- Water surface monitoring equipments are also deployed at incident site to augment the ongoing rescue and relief operation.
- Survey of surrounding area carried out by technical team of GSI.
- DDMA Dima Hasao activated the District Level Incident Response Team (IRT).


6. Deployment of Armed Forces/NDRF: -

Army: -

- Rescue teams of Indian Army including Engineer task Force are deployed at incident side for rescue and relief operation.

NDRF: -

- 01 team of NDRF along with necessary equipment deployed for search and rescue operation at incident site.
